Westchester County is seeking a dynamic, analytical and experienced candidate to serve as the County's Chief Fiscal Officer with responsibility of all duties of County Comptroller and County Treasurer and is responsible for the administration of the financial affairs of the County as established in the County Charter or governed by State law. The Department of Finance is responsible for accounts payable, purchasing, employee payroll, debt management, pension administration, revenue investment, tax collection, certiorari tax judgment processing and employee benefit function. In the execution of this responsibility the incumbent is accountable for the collection, receipt, and custody of all County funds and funds held in trust accounts, including securities; the audit and payment of claims against the County; and the maintenance of all accounts. In addition, the incumbent is responsible for the investment of County funds; the administration of the County Worker's Compensation Program and the County's employee benefit program including monitoring of loss experience and the conduct of internal audits.

With an approved 2022 operating budget of \$2.2 Billion the County is proud to be the only county in New York State with two AAA bond ratings - by both Standard & Poor's and Fitch. And the Moody's rating is Aa1, which is the second highest rating possible.

A Master's Degree in Accounting, Finance, Business or Public Administration is preferred and seven to ten years of experience in progressively responsible governmental financial/accounting positions including five years of which must have been in a supervisory or administrative capacity.
